- o 2,061 meters installed: 687 in Laguna Vista, 96 in Port Isabel, and 1,278 in South Padre Island
- Projected time to complete was in April. Will happen for South Padre and Laguna Vista. Port Isabel behind still needs to install 1,508 meters
- Keep it in-house for installing the meters
